## <u>IDA Hearing – Airosmith, Inc.</u>

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Good morning. CHAIRMAN SUTTON: It is now 8:00 a.m. on Monday, May 13, 2019. Ι will call to order the public hearing of the Industrial Development Agency of Saratoga County that is being held in the temporary offices of the Saratoga Springs City Hall at 15 Vanderbilt Avenue in Saratoga Springs. The Agency previously received an application and approved a project submitted by Airosmith, Inc. (the Applicant) now located at 32 Clinton Street in Saratoga Springs on behalf of Smith Cassier Real Estate Holding Company, LLC, a limited liability corporation (the Company).

The Company has requested that this Agency 15 16 undertake a project consisting of (a) the acquisition of an interest of approximately 17 18 0.519 acres of land comprised of one tax map 19 parcel and portions of two abutting tax map 20 parcels located at 318 West Avenue, in the City 21 of Saratoga Springs, Saratoga County, New York (the Land), and (b) the construction on the 22 23 Land of a 10,400 square foot (revised from 9,000 square feet) facility to be operated by 24 25 the Applicant for its corporate headquarters

IDA Hearing - Airosmith, Inc. 1 and housing related to the wireless 2 3 infrastructure development industry (the Facility), and (c) the acquisition and 4 5 installation of certain machinery and equipment (the Equipment) in that building, together with 6 the Land and the Facility being known as the 7 Project Facility. The total (revised) cost 8 associated with the acquisition, construction 9 and installation of the Project Facility is now 10 presently estimated to be \$3,665,000. 11 The Agency is considering whether to 1213 undertake the Project and finance the Project 14 by executing a mortgage or mortgages (the Mortgage) to secure borrowing or borrowings by 15 16 the Applicant (the Loan) in an aggregate principal amount sufficient to took finance all 17 18 or a portion of the cost to acquire, construct 19 and install the Project Facility and the cost 20 of the Loan, currently estimated to be 21 approximately \$2,900,000, up from 2.4 Million being sought in the initial application. 22 23 If the undertaking of the Project and execution and delivery of the Mortgage is 24 approved by this Agency, then (A) the Project 25

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2	may be granted such exemptions with respect to
3	real property taxes, mortgage recording tax,
4	and state and local sales tax as are applicable
5	to commercial service facilities as described
6	in the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy
7	adopted on October 14, 2014, subject to
8	deviation as determined by the Agency, (B) the
9	Project Facility will be acquired, constructed,
10	and installed by the Agency and leased (with an
11	obligation to purchase) or sold by the Agency
12	to the Company pursuant to a project agreement
13	(the Agreement), and (C) the Company and the
14	Applicant will be the initial users of the
15	Project Facility, and (D) the Mortgage will be
16	a special obligation of the Agency payable
17	solely out of certain proceeds of the Agreement
18	and certain other assets of the Agency pledged
19	to the repayment of the Loan.
20	I will now ask Special Counsel to the
21	Agency, James Carminucci if proper legal notice
22	was provided for the Public Hearing in
23	accordance with regulations.
24	MR. CARMINUCCI: Yes. Notice of the
25	Public Hearing was published in The Saratogian

IDA Hearing - Airosmith, Inc. 1 on April 20, 2019 and notices were sent to the 2 3 involved taxing jurisdictions. CHAIRMAN SUTTON: Thank you. 4 Agency members present today are Arthur 5 Johnson, Patrick Greene, Andrea DiDomenico, 6 Michael Mooney, Walter Wintsch and myself, 7 8 Rodney Sutton, Chairman. Staff present today are Scott Duffy, CEO; Jeffrey Many, CFO; and 9 Special Counsel, James A. Carminucci, also 10 serving as Bond Counsel. 11 On the application, this request for the 1213 Project was last presented to this Agency on April 8, 2019. That application and supporting 14 material have been available for review by 15 16 interested parties since April 4, 2019 at the IDA office at 50 West High Street in Ballston 17 18 Spa. 19 Since the presentation of that application, are there any additional comments 20 21 or thoughts from staff or the Applicant that need to be provided at this public hearing 22 23 relative to the revised application that is now being submitted. 24 25 **MR. TOOHEY:** Mr. Chair, I'm Mike

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2	Toohey. I'm representing the applicant on
3	this. The mortgage amount has been committed
4	to and all city approvals needed with regard to
5	the construction of this project have been
6	approved by the various City boards. As a
7	result, subject to the findings of the Agency,
8	we're prepared to move forward with the project
9	rapidly.
10	CHAIRMAN SUTTON: Dennis?
11	MR. BROBSTON: Mr. Chairman, I have
12	been asked to amend two pages of the
13	application. Just there was a number that was
14	incorrect on both the 10,400 square foot for
15	the building so I replaced that on the memo
16	originally and then on that page and just
17	wanted to hand it up to you today. Other than
18	that, everything is the same.
19	CHAIRMAN SUTTON: I'm, therefore, now
20	going to open the hearing for any input from
21	the public for response or comment relative to
22	the application. Any comments from anyone?
23	(No response.)
24	CHAIRMAN SUTTON: Is there any other
25	input in this public hearing relative to this

5	we'll close the public hearing?
